Blood drives, held daily in communities across our state, ensure a safe and adequate supply of blood – as blood is not a product that can be manufactured.

The Food and Drug Administration strictly regulates the blood donation process. These regulations ensure the safety of both the blood donors and future recipients. Providence strongly supports these safety protocols to ensure the products we provide to our patients are not harmful.

House Bill 2541 establishes new Oregon-specific staffing requirements for blood drives. Creating additional hurdles for a process that is already heavily regulated and relies on volunteerism and donations, raises concerns.
