• I am writing to stress the importance of passing the following bills to protect minor children...

As of now there are no guidelines, no laws or rules to protect what happens to data collected or information derived from students being required to take High Stakes Standardized Tests. The following standards must be put into place at the very least.

<u>HB 2709</u> Directs State Board of Education to adopt standards for rights of parents, legal guardians and students relating to student education records.

- <u>HB 2710</u> Directs Department of Education to issue privacy risk assessment of any data system, program or contract involving student education records.
- <u>HB 2711</u> Establishes standards relating to personal identifying information that State Board of Education must follow when adopting rules related to student education records.
- <u>HB 2712</u> Directs State Board of Education to adopt schedule of civil penalties for violations of rules related to creation, use, custody and disclosure, including access, of student education records.
