- Applied topically to the skin
- Low amount of THC less than 1%

Our Proposal

Expand the sales distribution beyond OLCC stores for topical products containing less than 1% THC to include:

- Alternative medical clinics (e.g. naturopath, chiropractic, physical therapy, massage, acupuncture)
- Grocery stores
- Health food stores
- Farmer's markets
- In-home parties
- Local specialty stores

Why not have sales only through the OLCC stores?

- Limited access for consumers
- Stigma associated with "marijuana" stores
- Consumers may not even know the products exist if limited to OLCC stores
- Limited shelf space
