Written Testimony before the House Rules Committee in Support of Senate Bill 28

Chair Rosenbaum, Vice-Chair Ferrioli, Senators Burdick, Boquist and Beyer,

Thank you for the opportunity to appear at today's hearing regarding Senate Bill 28. The Oregon Association of County Clerk's (OACC) supports Senate Bill 28, Oregon Secretary of State's housekeeping bill. The minor fixes to the statutes recommended by OACC include:

- Section 1: Eliminates the 'mark' a clerk makes on the absentee voter's signature envelope. This process is currently not required on all other signature envelopes. Provides consistent procedure for all signature envelopes.
- Section 2 &3: Technical clarification from 'registration card' to 'registration record' due to digital signatures available through Department of Motor Vehicles.
- Sections 4: Eliminates the notice to districts requesting the updated information on the board members by 'certified mail'. Counties will continue to use the best mode of communication available for the district's updated information such as regular mail, e-mail or by fax.

The Oregon Association of County Clerks supports SB 28.
