S.B. 439

Allocate \$22 million annually to an Outdoor Education Account to provide Oregon students with outdoor school programs during their 5th or 6th grade year



S.B. 439

- (a) Is a **six-day**, residential, **hands-on educational experience** featuring field study opportunities for students learning about:
 - (A) Soil, water, plants and animals;
 - (B) The **role of timber, agriculture and other natural resources in the economy** of this state;
 - (C) The **interrelationship of nature, natural resources, economic development** and **career opportunities** in this state; and
 - (D) The importance of **preserving this state's environment and natural resources.**



S.B. 439

- (b) Is **integrated with local school curricula** in a manner that assists students in **meeting state standards** related to science, technology, engineering and mathematics, and international standards related to science.
- (c) Provides students with opportunities to **develop leadership, critical thinking and decision-making skills.**
- (d) Addresses **inequity of outdoor educational opportunities for underserved children** in Oregon
