2	To the President of the United States and the Senate and the House of
3	Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled:
4	We, your memorialists, the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly of the
5	State of Oregon, in legislative session assembled, respectfully represent as
6	follows:
7	Whereas there are approximately 22 million veterans living today, 5.3
8	million of whom live in rural areas; and
9	Whereas 3.2 million veterans who live in rural areas are enrolled in the
10	Veterans Health Administration (VHA) health care system; and
11	Whereas 2.6 million patients enrolled in the VHA health care system have
12	a service-connected disability; and
13	Whereas 960,000 veterans from rural areas have a service-connected disa-
14	bility; and
15	Whereas a disproportionate share of all service members are from rural
16	areas; and
17	Whereas many veterans from rural areas return to their rural communi-
18	ties after their service period; and
19	Whereas since its inception in 2007, the Veterans Health Administration
20	Office of Rural Health has supported nearly 2,000 projects and programs to
21	make health care more accessible for veterans in rural areas; and

1	Whereas despite this progress, the Office of Rural Health has made in
2	cremental and inconsistent progress in building an accessible health care
3	infrastructure to deliver services to veterans in rural areas; and
4	Whereas health care for veterans in rural areas remains more costly and
5	more difficult to access than health care for veterans in urban areas; and
6	Whereas efforts should be made to improve the quality of care at and ef
7	ficiency of health care facilities serving veterans in rural areas; now, there
8	fore,
9	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
10	That we, the members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, urge
11	the Congress of the United States to support the mission of the Veterans
12	Health Administration Office of Rural Health and efforts to improve access
13	to health care for veterans in rural areas; and be it further
14	Resolved, That we urge Congress to improve and support outreach efforts
15	and accelerate the pace of efforts to bring health care to veterans in rura
16	communities; and be it further
17	Resolved, That a copy of this memorial shall be sent to the President o
18	the United States, to the Senate Majority Leader, to the Speaker of the
19	House of Representatives and to each member of the Oregon Congressiona
20	Delegation.
