## Why add Pharmacy Technicians to the Oregon State Board of Pharmacy (OSBP)?

In 2005, the Oregon Legislature required licensing of all pharmacy technicians. This was a bold step that UFCW Local 555 supported. There are currently over 6,000 certified pharmacy technicians and over 750 first-year pharmacy technicians in Oregon that are regulated by the OSBP. Oregon has a long-standing history of stakeholder participation in her Boards and Commissions . While UFCW legislative programs include monitoring government agency's actions to ensure our members interests are represented, it is important that pharmacy technicians have a voice at the table and are regular participants as policies within this industry are considered.

UFCW Local 555 has worked with the Oregon State Board of Pharmacy and other stakeholders to provide an outline of requested qualifications for these potential volunteer board members. Under SB148, licensed pharmacy technicians must, at the time of appointment:

- (A) Be licensed and in good standing to perform the duties of a pharmacy technician in this state;
- (B) Be engaged in the performance of the duties of a pharmacy technician in this state; and
- (C) Have at least three years of experience in performing the duties of a pharmacy technician in this state after licensure
