The proposed Bill does not require any type of guidance or supervision of said training facilitates.

As a rural resident, I feel such a facility would cause risk to myself, guests and animals. FMJ is commonly used for target practice and training....this type of ammunition has the ability to travel miles. Should someone miss their target, have an errant shot, or shot ricochet, it could travel into an adjacent area.

I would minimally ask for a 2 mile radius be free from any private or public trail, road, or residence as an addendum to this bill.
