Debt-Free Education Summary (SB 81 -1)

Overview:

Requires tuition for qualifying courses offered at community colleges to be waived if a prospective student meets specific criteria.

Tuition Criteria:

- 1. Offered at a community college within the state, and
- 2. Required for a certificate or associates degree, as determined by HECC.

Student Qualifications:

- 1. Student must be a resident of the state for 12 months prior to beginning courses.
- 2. Must have graduated from an Oregon high school within two years from beginning date of waiver.
- 3. Has not previously earned more than 90 quarters hours at post-secondary institution
- 4. Student filed FAFSA and utilized all state/federal grants available to them.
- 5. The amount of tuition waived shall be the amount owed <u>after</u> subtracting all applicable state and federal grants. ("last dollar in" method)
- 6. Students will submit a \$50 co-pay per term.

Ongoing Requirements:

- 1. Student must maintain an average GPA of 2.5 or better for each term in which waiver is requested.
- 2. Student must participate in academic advising to help ensure degree achievement.

Financing Model:
