SUMMARY

Directs Oregon Medical Board and Oregon State Board of Nursing to adopt rules regarding diagnosis and treatment of Lyme disease. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Medical Board and the Oregon State 5 Board of Nursing shall each adopt rules regarding the diagnosis and 6 treatment of Lyme disease.

7 (2) The rules adopted under this section must:

8 (a) Permit professionals regulated by the boards to diagnose and treat, in manners consistent with the standards of care guidelines de-9 veloped by the International Lyme and Associated Diseases Society, 10 Lyme disease and associated viral, bacterial and parasitic diseases; and 11 (b) Establish disciplinary procedures that consider as a mitigating 12factor whether, in diagnosing or treating Lyme disease or associated 13 diseases, a professional who is facing discipline followed evidence-14 based diagnosis and treatment guidelines not recognized by the boards. 1516 SECTION 2. The Oregon Medical Board and the Oregon State Board of Nursing shall adopt rules under section 1 of this 2015 Act not later 17 than January 1, 2016. 18

19 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-20 ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-
