Oregon Department of Administrative Services Statewide QRF Program

DAS' ROLE:

- Qualify Community Rehabilitation Program providers
- Publish a list of products and services available through the program
- Determine the price of all QRF products and services provided to public agencies
- Make rules as necessary to carry out the purposes of ORS 279.835 to 279.855, 279A.025(4) and 279C.335
- Provide technical assistance to QRF providers and Public Agencies

Qualify QRF Providers

- Meet Nonprofit Community Rehabilitation Program (CRP) requirements
- Provide employment services to Oregonians with disabilities
 - 75% of direct labor organization wide must be performed by employees with qualifying disabilities
- Comply with applicable health and safety regulations
- Meet annual reporting requirements
 - When sales exceed \$100,000, obtain an independent CPA audit of direct labor calculation

Determine Product and Service Suitability

(Procurement List)

QRF product or service requirements include:

- The requesting QRF must be currently in good standing in the program
- The product or service must meet a Public Agency Need
- Workmanship must meet the Quality Standards of Industry
- The product or service must meet the purpose of the QRF program
- All QRF products and services are posted to the Procurement List (<u>http://dasapp.oregon.gov/qrf/index.aspx</u>)
 - Interactive database to facilitate public agency contract development

Determine all QRF Product and Service Prices

- QRF product and service pricing must recover costs
- Pricing is developed using computer-based costing tools
 - Price for QRF products and services must be reasonable {OAR 125-055-0020(2)(d)}
- Contracts are not competitively solicited
- There are over 550 State and Local QRF Contracts
