Law enforcement authorities in Lane County, Oregon have created a program that explains the realities of officer-involved shootings while dispelling common myths relating to the use of deadly force. This 17 minute video tackles seven of the most prevalent myths surrounding law enforcement use of force, discusses dynamics involved in police shootings and the related investigations, and highlights the importance of a coordinated, collaborative and transparent investigation and subsequent community outreach. The video also highlights the limitations of human perception, reaction and performance, and introduces viewers to the force-dynamics and the science associated with investigating life-or-death confrontations and the use of deadly force.
