- Fees and Other Changes
 - The agency's budget includes the following fee changes:
 - × An increase in the Solid Waste Permit fee
 - An increase in the Wastewater Permit fee; includes increase in General Fund investment
 - An increase Ballast Water Management fee; includes increase in General Fund investment
 - × An increase Oil Spill Prevention fee
 - × Consolidation of and increase in the Solid Water Disposal fee

Department of Environmental Quality 2015-17 Governor's Budget/Revisions



- Appropriation/budget bill changes
 - If the agency is awarded federal grants for Community Scale Air Toxics Air Monitoring Grant and Diesel Emission Reduction it will be requesting additional federal limitation and a limited duration position for the Air Toxics grant.
 - The agency is seeking to reclassify employees to align their classification with their workload and responsibilities.
