WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) set standards for coordinated care organizations (CCOs) to integrate delivery of mental health services with physical health services. Directs OHA provide grants until June 30, 2017, to CCOs meeting standards. Appropriates \$1 million General Fund to OHA to that end. Defines “integrated behavioral health care.” Adds data on use of primary care homes offering integrated services, to existing required quality measures. Requires CCOs offer qualified mental health providers to members. Bars CCOs from restricting member access to mental health services. Requires integrated services at one location. Permits use of appropriate billing codes by mental health providers at integrated locations. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
