 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "African Elephant Con-

5 servation and Legal Ivory Possession Act of 2015".

6 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.

7 Except as otherwise specifically provided, whenever in8 this Act an amendment or repeal is expressed in terms

1	of an amendment to, or repeal of, a provision, the ref-
2	erence shall be considered to be made to a provision of
3	the African Elephant Conservation Act (16 U.S.C. 4201
4	et seq.).
5	SEC. 3. LIMITED EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN AFRICAN ELE-
6	PHANT IVORY.
7	Section 2203 (16 U.S.C. 4223) is amended—
8	(1) by inserting "(a) IN GENERAL.—" before
9	the first sentence;
10	(2) by inserting "and subsection (b) of this sec-
11	tion" after "2202(e)"; and
12	(3) by adding at the end the following:
13	"(b) EXEMPTION.—Nothing in this Act or subsection
14	(a) or (d) of section 9 of the Endangered Species Act of
15	1973 (16 U.S.C. 1538) shall be construed to prohibit im-
16	portation or exportation, or to require permission of the
17	Secretary for importation or exportation, of—
18	"(1) any raw ivory or worked ivory—
19	"(A) imported solely for purposes of be-
20	coming part of a museum's permanent collec-
21	tion, return to a lending museum, or display in
22	a museum; or
23	"(B) exported solely for purposes of—
24	"(i) display in a foreign museum; or

1	"(ii) return to a foreign person who
2	lent such ivory to a museum in the United
3	States;
4	"(2) any raw ivory or worked ivory that was
5	lawfully importable into the United States on Feb-
6	ruary 24, 2014, regardless of when acquired; or
7	"(3) any worked ivory that was previously law-
8	fully possessed in the United States.".
9	SEC. 4. PLACEMENT OF UNITED STATES FISH AND WILD-
10	LIFE SERVICE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
11	IN EACH AFRICAN ELEPHANT RANGE COUN-
12	TRY.
13	Part I (16 U.S.C. 4211 et seq.) is amended by adding
14	at the end the following:
15	"SEC. 2105. PLACEMENT OF UNITED STATES FISH AND
16	WILDLIFE SERVICE LAW ENFORCEMENT OF-
17	FICER IN EACH AFRICAN ELEPHANT RANGE
18	COUNTRY.
19	"The Secretary, in coordination with the Secretary
20	of State, may station one United States Fish and Wildlife
21	Service law enforcement officer in the primary United
22	States diplomatic or consular post in each African country
23	that has a significant population of African elephants, who
24	shall assist local wildlife rangers in the protection of Afri-
25	can elephants and facilitate the apprehension of individ-

uals who illegally kill, or assist the illegal killing of, Afri can elephants.".

3 SEC. 5. CERTIFICATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE FISH4 ERMEN'S PROTECTIVE ACT OF 1967.

5 Section 2202 of the African Elephant Conservation
6 Act (16 U.S.C. 4222) is amended by adding at the end
7 the following:

8 "(g) CERTIFICATION.—When the Secretary of the In-9 terior finds that a country, directly or indirectly, is a sig-10 nificant transit or destination point for illegal ivory trade, 11 the Secretary shall certify such fact to the President with 12 respect to the country for the purposes of section 8(a) of 13 the Fishermen's Protective Act of 1967 (22 U.S.C. 1978 14 (a)).".

15 SEC. 6. TREATMENT OF ELEPHANT IVORY.

16 Section 2203 (16 U.S.C. 4223) is further amended17 by adding at the end the following:

18 "(c) TREATMENT OF ELEPHANT IVORY.—Nothing in
19 this Act or the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (16
20 U.S.C. 1538) shall be construed—

"(1) to prohibit, or to authorize prohibiting, the
possession, sale, delivery, receipt, shipment, or transportation of African elephant ivory, or any product
containing African elephant ivory, that has been lawfully imported or crafted in the United States; or

"(2) to authorize using any means of determining for purposes of this Act or the Endangered
Species Act of 1973 whether African elephant ivory
has been lawfully imported, including any presumption or burden of proof applied in such determination, other than such means used by the Secretary
as of February 24, 2014.".

8 SEC. 7. SPORT-HUNTED ELEPHANT TROPHIES.

9 Section 2203 (16 U.S.C. 4223) is further amended10 by adding at the end the following:

11 "(d) SPORT-HUNTED ELEPHANT TROPHIES.—Nothing in this Act or subsection (a) or (d) of section 9 of 12 the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1538) 13 14 shall be construed to prohibit any citizen or legal resident 15 of the United States, or an agent of such an individual, from importing a sport-hunted African elephant trophy 16 under section 2202(e) of this Act, if the country in which 17 18 the elephant was taken has an elephant population on Appendix II of CITES at the time the trophy is imported. 19 "(e) Relationship to the Convention.—Nothing 20 21 in this section shall be construed as modifying or repealing 22 the Secretary's duties to implement CITES and the ap-23 pendices thereto, or as modifying or repealing section 8A 24 or 9(c) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1537a and 1538(c)).". 25

1SEC. 8. AFRICAN ELEPHANT CONSERVATION ACT FINAN-2CIAL ASSISTANCE PRIORITY AND REAUTHOR-3IZATION.

4 (a) FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PRIORITY.—Section
5 2101 of the African Elephant Conservation Act (16 U.S.C.
6 4211) is amended by redesignating subsections (e) and (f)
7 as subsections (f) and (g), respectively, and by inserting
8 after subsection (d) the following:

9 "(e) PRIORITY.—In providing financial assistance 10 under this section, the Secretary shall give priority to 11 projects designed to facilitate the acquisition of equipment 12 and training of wildlife officials in ivory producing coun-13 tries to be used in anti-poaching efforts.".

(b) REAUTHORIZATION.—Section 2306(a) of the African Elephant Conservation Act (16 U.S.C. 4245(a)) is
amended by striking "2007 through 2012" and inserting
"2016 through 2020".
