I have Adrenal Insufficiency and had an Adrenal Crisis this summer in August. I was close to fainting several times, I was confused, and I was having difficulty giving myself the shot of Solu-Cortef. I called my husband who called 911. EMS arrived, but could not give me the shot. Eventually they ended up mixing the solution and drawing it out with the syringe, but they could not administer the shot. I was so anxious and confused by this point that it was difficult to administer the shot myself. I am glad that I was able to, as it was a life-threatening situation. EMS then took me to the ER where the doctors were unsure how to treat me and unfamiliar with Adrenal Insufficiency. If this had happened to my child, or your child, this would be unacceptable and extremely dangerous.
