Dear Senate Committee On Judiciary,

With the expansion of "domestic violence" as defined in SB 525, a reasonable person would have trouble determining how the law is to be followed. Judges must be limited in their ability to take away rights of people who have not been convicted of any crime or have a legitimate, verified order against them. The "dash 1" and "dash 3" amendments appear to correct this problem and clarify the language and intent of the bill. If you move forward with this bill, please include these 2 amendments.
