- General knowledge of the concerns, conditions and problems of the physical, social and economic environment of Oregon.
- The need for diversity of experience and education related to the functions and duties of council and priorities of Public Law 96-501.
- Not more than one member of the Oregon delegation to the council shall reside within the boundary of an area that includes the First and Third Congressional Districts and the Portland, Oregon, Metropolitan Statistical Area.
- Council member, or member of the council member's household, shall not own or have any beneficial interest in any stock or indebtedness of any utility or direct service industry.
- United States citizenship and one year's residency in Oregon prior to appointment.
- Member shall not hold any other elected or appointed public lucrative office or be principally engaged in any other business or vocation.
- Serve at the pleasure of the Governor; removal for specific causes enumerated in ORS 469.830 upon written notice and public hearing.

# **DUTIES AND AUTHORITY:**

- Perform duties as specified in public Law 96-501, the Pacific Northwest Electric Power Planning and Conservation Act of 1980 (*e.g.*, administer regional power plan, monitor and protect of fish and wildlife, collaborate with scientific and statistical advisory committee to gather economic, social, environmental, and other scientific information).
- Report to Governor and legislature October 1 of each year.
