Hi Beth,

We've got a staggering amount of work to do to achieve the needed reductions in carbon emissions identified in the 2013 Oregon Global Warming Commission report.

Even if Oregon:

- meets all new load growth with conservation or EE (we're halfway there),
- maintains the RPS to 2025,
- replaces Boardman with 50/50 natural gas and renewables in 2021,
- and passes the clean fuels program (which it just did),

Oregon greenhouse gas emissions are projected to level off at about 60 MT CO2e vs. the needed reduction to 14 MT CO2e, 75% below the 1990 level, by 2050 (see chart below). Today, EE investments meet 50% of new load growth, so we need to dig deeper for savings.
