I consider this to be a breach of the trust that I have placed in you as a leader in the NFB, but also a slap in the face of all the members who counted on you and trusted you to represent our position as our Legislative Chair.

I have already notified Lisa and Elana that you no longer serve as our Legislative Chair, and that any matters that may arise this session are to come directly to me.

As for your role in the NFB of Oregon:

I will give you the opportunity to resign your board position and position as Chapter President quietly and without event, if you do so in writing within the next 24 hours. If you choose not to do so, I will bring this matter to the board for whatever action they deem appropriate.
