HB 2405: State School Fund Donations Senate Committee on Education April 23, 2015

Good morning Chair Roblan and members of the Senate Education Committee. For the record, I am Jan McComb speaking on behalf of the Oregon Education Department. I am here today to speak in favor of HB 2405. HB 2405 will allow the department to accept donations to the State School Fund.

## Background

The State School Fund consists primarily of the General Fund and lottery funds the Legislature appropriates each biennium to fund kindergarten through grade 12 education. The Oregon Department of Education combines other school revenue, such as local property taxes, with state dollars and distributes the total to Oregon's 197 school districts and 19 Education Service Districts according to the equalization formula laid out in statute. For the 2013-15 biennium, the Legislature appropriated \$6.65 billion to the State School Fund.

#### Issue

Occasionally, the department receives donations to the State School Fund from individuals. There is not clear legal authority in the statute for the department to accept those funds.

## Legislation

HB 2405 is a technical fix that would clarify the Oregon Department of Education may accept donations to the State School Fund.
