**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to solicit and accept gifts, grants, donations, and other moneys from public and private sources for State School Fund. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Non-controversial nature of measure
- Opportunity to streamline and clarify State School Fund sub-accounts identified during review process
- Need to explicitly state that ODE may accept gifts, grants, and donations
- No existing regulation barring ODE from soliciting or accepting gifts, grants, donations, or other moneys from public or private sources

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

**BACKGROUND:** The measure explicitly allows ODE to accept gifts, donations, and other similar sources of income. There is currently no prohibition barring ODE from accepting these types of benefits.
