SB 296 Timeline

July 1, 2015	Claimant files claim for assistance with Department of Revenue for expenses incurred during calendar year 2014.
November 2015	Revenue issues 2014 assistance check.
	If SB 296 becomes law, DOR will inform claimants of the new service delivery model at the time the check is issued.
January 1, 2016	Elderly Rental Assistance program as it currently exists is repealed but for provisions allowing claimants to make a claim based on their 2015 expenses.
	If SB 296 becomes law, DOR will update 2015 forms and instructions to inform claimants of the new service delivery model.
July 1, 2016	Claimant files claim for assistance with Department of Revenue for expenses incurred during calendar year 2015.
November 2016	Revenue issues 2015 assistance check.
	If SB 296 becomes law, DOR will inform claimants of the new service delivery model at the time the check is issued.
December 31, 2016	Provisions relating to DORs ability to issue assistance checks based on calendar year 2015 expenses are repealed.
July 1, 2017	Funding and administration of the new service delivery model beings at OHCS.
