**BACKGROUND:** During the 2014 Interim, as part of the administrative rule review process, Legislative Counsel identified a lack of explicit authority with Oregon Administrative Rule 410-121-0135 (establishes a pharmacy lock-in program, the Pharmacy Management Program). House Bill 2306 addresses the problem by granting additional authority to Oregon Health Authority to use the pharmacy lock-in as an intervention in its drug use review of prescription drugs in the medical assistance program.
