Dear chair and members of the House Committee on Energy and the Environment:

On behalf of 350 Eugene, representing nearly 1,000 members engaged with our local chapter, we are writing in strong support of House Bill 3470 (known as Climate Stability and Justice Act of Oregon).

350 is building a global climate movement. That movement is rising from the bottom up all over the world, and is uniting to create the solutions that will ensure a better future for all. (The number 350 means climate safety: to preserve a livable planet, scientists tell us we must reduce the amount of CO2 in the atmosphere from its current level of 400 parts per million to below 350 ppm.)

The consensus of best science tells us that we must be at least 15% below 1990 greenhouse gas levels by 2020, and at least 75% below by 2050. In 2013, Oregon's Legislature passed a non-binding policy goal to meet these targets. But current policy is inadequate to the task and Oregon is not on target to meet the goals. If passed and implemented, HB 3470 would effectively limit greenhouse gas emissions in Oregon.

We believe that HB 3470 is the most feasible, legal and effective policy option to limit greenhouse gas emission for Oregon at this time:

- 1) It very specifically and clearly mandates reductions in greenhouse gas emissions by 2020 through 2050.
- 2) It would set those greenhouse gas emissions limits based on the best available science.
- 3) The law sets five year truth checks mandating further reductions if needed.
- 4) California adopted a similar approach (AB32) in 2006, designed to be joined by other jurisdictions, so Oregon can join an effort with a jurisdiction with a much larger economy, so as to reinforce collective action.
- 5) Oregon opinion polls show the public is supportive of a carbon cap. California voted support for their law by a 24% margin.
