If it weren't for her husband's income there is no way she could make it on her own. Her pay covers only groceries and a few bills. There is no way she could live off what she makes. We've got a lot of families that live in too small housing. They don't have transportation. They can't afford extra things like a car and insurance. There is a lot of single moms. My coworkers depend on their husband's income because none of us can make a living on our own. Teachers get paid more than we do.
