Requires study report to be submitted to interim legislative committees by December 31, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Oregon Business Development Department helps facilitate the deployment and utilization of telecommunications infrastructure to support innovation, create economic opportunities and build quality communities throughout Oregon. House Bill 3274A would direct Business Oregon to conduct a study regarding methods to expand broadband and telecommunications infrastructure in rural cities and counties in Oregon. The report would be submitted to the interim legislative committees on economic development by December 31, 2016.

The vote count in the Rural Communities, Land Use and Water Committee was 7-0, and the House vote count was 58-0-2.
