While we support clean-energy technologies like wind and solar energy and energy efficiency upgrades, we are concerned that HB 3470 will negatively impact our brothers and sisters in the electrical utility industry.

As we consider policies to transition away from coal generated energy to cleaner technologies, we want to be mindful of all workers in Oregon and are concerned that HB 3470 will result in an immediate loss of family wage jobs for electrical utility workers.
