Program Description

Work-Based Education (WBE)

- Provide quality career technical education in conjunction with a "real-world" production component
 - Revenue from services/products used to offset costs of materials and supplies
- Curriculum aligns with industry-specific skill sets and college requirements
- Some WBE instructors assist inmates with job search/placement or coordinate with institution transition coordinators

 - 144 hours/year trade-specific instruction
- Receive BOLI journeyman card upon successful completion
 - Opportunity to test for electrical license

Work-Based Education/Pre-Apprenticeship Hybrid Program

Construction-Related Employment for Women (CREW)

- Proposed by PCC to be facilitated at CCCF
- PCC worked with BOLI to certify as a construction trades pre-apprenticeship
- Differs from other existing DOC programs built around full-time jobs:
 - CREW is an education program, which requires additional funds to start and run the program
