Proposed amendments to HB 2300

- 1. Raise age to 18 people under 18 can't consent to experimental treatment independently in OR
- 2. Develop process like OR Death With Dignity Act:
 - a. Two separate MD's with waiting period
 - b. Doctors must be clear that patient is:
 - i. Competent
 - ii. Not being coerced or unduly influenced by family or friends
 - iii. Clearly understands that there is no evidence that treatment is effective
 - iv. Clearly understands that all medical expenses from here on out will be self-pay
 - c. Forms to submit to OHA
 - d. OHA tracks patients until death or 10 years after treatment, whichever comes first.
 - i. Adverse effects
 - ii. Positive effects
 - iii. Costs
 - iv. Demographics of patients who use the process
 - e. Study use of this process compared to compassionate use process
- 3. Six year sunset
- 4. After Phase 2 only (not after Phase 1, when hasn't been proved to have any positive effect (this provision least important to change)
