Revenue Summary

Senate Bill 128 appropriates \$213,936 General Fund to the Oregon State Police (OSP) for pay parity for telecommunicators employed by OSP.

Summary of Public Safety Subcommittee Action

Senate Bill 128 defines "comparable" for the purpose of establishing base pay for OSP telecommunicators as the base pay for telecommunicators employed by the five Oregon public safety answering points with the most employees. The bill's provisions apply to arbitration hearings commenced on or after the bill's effective date.

Agency Support - 007

The Subcommittee recommended appropriation of \$213,936 General Fund to the Agency Support Division of OSP to pay for adjustments to salaries for telecommunicators caused by the change in the definition of "comparable" for the purpose of establishing the base pay for the department's telecommunicators.
