HB 3308 - A relates to underrepresented communities in higher education. The Higher Education Coordination Commission (HECC) is directed to convene and staff a workgroup to analyze and develop recommendations to address disparities in higher education within traditionally marginalized, underserved or underrepresented communities. The HECC will submit a report detailing the analysis and recommendations to the interim legislative committees on higher education by June 30, 2016.

The measure was previously heard in both the House House Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development Committee as well as the Senate Committee on Education.

The measure has a \$48,092 General Fund impact and one position (0.25FTE) in the 2015-17 biennium.

Analysis:

The bill requires the Higher Education Coordination Commission (HECC) to convene and staff a workgroup to analyze and develop recommendations to address disparities in higher education within traditionally marginalized, underserved or underrepresented communities. The HECC is directed to submit a report detailing the analysis and recommendations to the interim legislative committees on higher education by June 30, 2016.

To complete this work the HECC anticipates the need for one limited-duration Operations and Policy Analysts 4 position for 12 months (0.25 FTE). This position, travel costs and other associated meeting expenses are anticipated to cost \$48,092 General Fund in the 2015-17 biennium. The fiscal impact to public universities and community colleges is estimated to be minimal.
