## SB 608 Relating to palliative care

SB 608 establishes the nine-member Palliative Care and Quality of Life Interdisciplinary Advisory Council in the Oregon Health Authority to advise the agency on establishing, maintaining, operating, and evaluating palliative care initiatives in Oregon. The bill also requires the Oregon Health Authority publish on its website information and resources about palliative care.

The Oregon Health Authority will support this new advisory council with existing staff and resources.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 608 be reported out do pass.
