SB 5510 Department of Energy

SB 5510 is the budget bill for the Oregon Department of Energy. The Department of Energy's mission is to reduce the long-term cost of energy for Oregonians. The agency's programs provide residential, commercial, and industrial incentives, set standards for energy conservation and use of renewable resources, and guide the siting of energy facilities in Oregon.

The Natural Resources Subcommittee recommends a total biennial budget of \$2,980,496 Lottery Funds for debt service, \$34,515,467 Other Funds, \$3,129,106 Federal Funds, \$140.8 million in non-limited Other Funds for small-scale energy loans, and \$104,000 in non-limited Federal Funds. This budget includes 105 positions or 104.50 full-time equivalent jobs. The Subcommittee approved the addition of four new key performance measures for the Energy Planning and Innovation Division.

The Natural Resources Subcommittee recommends SB 5510 be amended by the -1 amendment and be reported out do pass as amended.
