## HB 2730 Relating to transportation

HB 2730 makes changes to ODOT's special registration license plates program. It eliminates the current limit on the number of different special license plates, and directs ODOT to create a new program and system for creating special registration license plates, to be approved administratively for production and distribution.

The measure also creates two new special registration license plates: a Portland Trailblazers plate, which will raise revenue for the Trail Blazers Foundation; and a Breast Cancer Awareness plate, which will raise money for the Oregon Health Authority Fund. Amendments specify how the Trails Blazers Foundation must use the funds raised, and add \$248,095 in Other Funds expenditure limitation to ODOT's budget to implement the new specialty license plate program and for the manufacturing costs of the two new specialty license plates created by the bill.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends HB 2730 be amended by the -A7 amendment and reported out do pass, as amended.
