## HB 2828 Relating to a study on financing health care in this state

HB 2828 extends the sunset date of provisions that require the Oregon Health Authority to conduct a study to examine options for financing health care delivery in Oregon. The study must include four different distinct options. OHA is required to report on the progress of the study during the 2016 session, and submit the final report by November 1, 2016. The agency is instructed to accept funding from a variety of sources to carry out this study, and a blank General Fund appropriation is included as well.

The proposed amendment appropriates \$300,000 to OHA for conducting the study. The agency could also accept funding from other sources, if any was available.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 2828 be amended by the -1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
