Work Session Recommendations

Senate Bill 844-A establishes the Task Force on Researching the Medical and Public Health Properties of Cannabis and specifies the duties of the Task Force. The measure addresses when a criminal conviction related to marijuana, as specified, may be eligible for expunction. In addition, the bill modifies limitations for medical marijuana cardholders who are in palliative or hospice care and specifies that transplant hospitals may not deny a transplant to someone on the basis that the person is a registry identification cardholder.
