Measure Description:

Authorizes employees of Department of Corrections, State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision and Oregon Corrections Enterprises who work in department building to store personal handgun and ammunition in vehicle.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision, Department of Corrections

Analysis:
