WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Department of State Lands, for purpose of identifying land that could be planned and zoned for residential use, to inventory department land, determine whether land is essential, useful or excessive in relation to plans of department, and report results to Legislative Assembly on or before October 1, 2016.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Request to refer bill to House Human Services and Housing Committee

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Presently, the Department of State Lands is not required to inventory department land to determine whether the land is essential, useful, or excessive in relation to department plans.

House Bill 2881 would require the Department of State Lands to inventory department lands and determine whether the land is "essential, useful, or excessive in relation to the department's plans" for a to-be-determined duration of time.
