WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Raises limit on fees for annual registration of animal remedy, veterinary biologic or pharmaceutical from \$75 to \$150. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

An animal remedy means any product used to prevent, inhibit or cure illness or enhance or protect the health or wellbeing of animals. Oregon law requires any animal remedy, veterinary biologic or pharmaceutical to be registered with the Oregon Department of Agriculture. The current registration fee is \$75.00 per product, per year.

Senate Bill 255 raises the limit on fees for annual registration of animal remedy, veterinary biologic or pharmaceutical to \$150.
