## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Extends tax credit to January 1, 2022 for loss of limb function claim.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Veterans use of credit
- Simple credit
- Has been in place since 1970s
- Credit utilization stable until 2012

# **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

An individual with a permanent and complete loss of function of at least two limbs is allowed a credit of \$50 against personal income taxes, or \$100 for two eligible individuals for a joint return. Taxpayers eligible for this credit are also eligible for the severe disability tax credit. Up until 2012, the use of the tax credit was relatively stable with about 500 people claiming around \$25,000 each year. In 2012, the number of claimants fell by 20 percent.
