Impact Explanation: The preliminary revenue impact provided here is based on the historical use of the tax credit as reported on tax returns and recent changes made to the tax credit. In 2014 the Legislature reinstated this tax credit and increased the percentage from 10 percent to 15 percent, effective with tax year 2014. Because tax year 2014 data are not yet available, these estimates are based on the assumptions used for the 2014 legislation. Further analysis will be done when the bill is in the Joint Committee on Tax Credits.
