WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Increases, from \$1 million to \$2 million, the maximum reimbursement amount from the Oregon Production Investment Fund to a local filmmaker or media production services company. Extends program through January 2024. Applies to fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2015. Takes effect on 91^{st} day following adjournment sine die.
