The revenue impact of this measure is indeterminate for the following reasons:

This measure amends the Lottery's mission statement in ORS 461.200 and would authorize the Oregon State Lottery Commission to implement an Oregon State Lottery Responsible Gambling Code of Practice. The Lottery Commission is further required to evaluate the operation of the Lottery annually using criteria and practices specified in the bill. The bill also requires the Lottery Commission to create a panel to conduct a review of the Commission's implementation of the Oregon State Lottery Responsible Gambling Code of Practice using criteria and practices specified in the bill.

The provisions of the bill and their implementation might increase the Lottery's administrative expenses or impact the Lottery's revenue. The bill could consequently reduce the amount of funds that would otherwise be transferred to state programs and services. Reduction in the funds transferred might also impact Lottery-backed bond capacity. These amounts, results and impacts are indeterminate. In general, every one percent decline in Lottery revenues amounts to approximately \$11 million less revenue transferred.
