WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adds assisting with recruiting and community outreach to primary purposes of Center for Policing Excellence. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Provisions of measure.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

Replaces measure.

BACKGROUND:

The Center for Policing Excellence (the Center) was created during the 2013 Legislative Session. Among the Center's primary purposes are: to make policing in Oregon more effective and efficient; to make communities safer; and to reduce, through the use of police practices proven to be effective, the number of offenders entering the criminal justice system.

House Bill 3406 A adds a new subsection (d) to ORS 181.685 addressing the Center to include in its primary purposes "assisting with recruiting and community outreach." House Bill 3406 A declares an emergency and is effective on passage.
