WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires clinical record of seclusion or confinement of person alleged to be mentally ill, who is in custody of hospital or other facility. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Civil hold/commitment process as distinguished from those in custody pursuant to criminal process
- Additional documentation requirement for persons on "hold" as part of civil commitment process
- Amount of time that persons are "held" at hospitals or other facilities pending civil commitment

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Hospitals and other care facilities are required to document treatments provided to each patient as a part of each individual's health record. House Bill 2363 also requires seclusion or confinement to be documented.
