### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Permits Oregon Department of Transportation to renew or replace out-of-state service members' driver's licenses without photograph.

### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• Existing State authority to permit license renewal without photograph

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Existing law requires a photograph on a driver's license, with only two permissive exceptions.

Senate Bill 494 allows a third, narrow, permissive allowance to the photograph requirement: only for renewal or replacement licenses, for service members stationed outside Oregon, who do not have an acceptable photograph on file with the Oregon Department of Transportation.
