WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Urges Congress to improve delivery of care to rural veterans.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Ongoing concerns involving federal Veterans Administration (VA) service delivery
- Ability of rural veterans to seek care outside of 40 mile rule

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

A high percentage of veterans live in rural areas. The Veterans Health Administration's Office of Rural Health was created in 2007 to better serve them, but improvements have been slow and inconsistent, as the Veterans Administration deals with ongoing scandals.

Senate Joint Memorial 11 urges Congress to support the mission of the Office of Rural Health; accelerate the pace of improvements, eliminate inefficiencies and barriers and make care accessible to rural veterans.
