WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Repeals obsolete laws relating to agricultural experiment stations. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

Removes repeal of John Jacob Astor Agriculture Experiment Station statutes.

BACKGROUND:

In 2014, the Legislative Assembly passed House Bill 4133 which directed the Legislative Counsel Office and the Department of Justice to review statutes each biennium to identify outdated, obsolete and duplicative laws.

House Bill 2910A is one of a series of measures this session prepared by Legislative Counsel under the requirements set forth in House Bill 4133 (2014); it would repeal obsolete laws relating to agricultural experiment stations.
