BACKGROUND:

Ivan Tadic, a barber who has been working in Multnomah Village for 60 years, will celebrate his 84th birthday on June 26, 2015.

Mr. Tadic was born in 1931 and grew up in Portland, attending Central Catholic High School and then barber college. After completing school, he enlisted in the Navy, where he was assigned to serve on the ship USS Daviess County, which participated in the attack on the beaches of Normandy in 1944, and he was later deployed for combat in the Korean War. After being honorably discharged in 1954, he returned to Portland where he began barbering in his father's Multnomah Village shop in southwest Portland. He has now been barbering in the same shop in Multnomah Village for 60 years and never wants to retire. He still has returning customers who received their first haircuts from him in 1955 and loyal customers fly and drive in from Washington and California to have him cut their hair.
